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Village Matters

Parish Council Business -

The Parish Council has said goodbye and a huge and heartfelt thank you to Cllr. Russell Pearce who has served the village for so many years as Councillor and Chair. There'll be more news soon of how the Parish Council intends celebrating Russ and everything he's done for Yoxford.

Congratulations to Cllr. Dave Tower who was elected as the new Chairperson and to Cllr. Ian Patterson who was elected as Vice Chair.

Donkey Meadow -

Yoxford Parish Council has been approached and offered first refusal on a purchase of Donkey Meadow; an area of land of about an acre sloping down to the river on Little Street almost opposite Strickland Manor Hill. It is currently owned by the Town Land Trust as a benefit for the church, and in recent years has been let.

The land is being offered for sale at a price of £25,000, with an additional clearance cost estimated at £23,500 and legal fees of £2,500. It will also require permanent ongoing maintenance and upkeep from the Parish Council budget. These costs are not yet known. There are also strict rules on how the land can be used by the Parish Council and what monies can be used to both buy and repurpose it.

The Parish Council currently has general reserves of approximately £19,000 (the financial records of the Parish Council are available on its website). These reserves are slowly decreasing as the funds are used to top up the shortfall between the Council's income and outgoings.

Other projects that the money might be used for include resurfacing the car park at the Village Hall, relocating the play area to beside the Village Hall, as well as sundry improvements to the village.
